























ACV has been used for centuries as a 'tonic', water purifier & natural antibiotic. Unpasteurised ACV contains natural beneficial bacteria & enzymes & is rich in vitamins, minerals & trace elements. If taken daily health benefits are as follows:



ACV (naturally high in acetic acid) adjusts rumen pH to levels which are optimum for fibre digestion, leading to more milk from forage. It is used to kill off internal parasites (worms) & decrease pathogens / bacteria which cause mastitis. Farmers also claim it can help with cases of Milk Fever, Acetonaemia, Arthritis, Fly control & Ring worm.



Used as an alternative to antibiotics—it can decrease piglet scouring, increase litter size, improve piglet survival, increase weight gain, as an alternative to antibiotic for mastitis.



Known to kill off internal parasites & pathogens / bacteria when fed in drinking water + reduces mites / lice when used for coop cleaning & disinfecting spray. Promotes clear airways, & reduced respiratory diseases. Helps with general health & therefore increased fertility / egg production.



Relieve stress, improve fibre digestion & absorption of nutrients, especially minerals. Used as an antibiotic for mastitis, & general antiseptic for wounds & to kill off internal parasites.



Helps with mineral absorption, (break down calcium deposits) & aiding digestion as it promotes the growth of healthy gut microflora. Aid in treating arthritis & laminitis & used to discourage flies (as non-toxic fly spray).



Can be used as a topical treatment to reduce itchy skin conditions, cleaning itchy ears, & improve dandruff. When fed, it is effective in reducing GI symptoms (such as gas/ flatulence) & recurrence of urinary tract infections.



Relieves stress, strengthens the immune system, digestion, prevent the development of illnesses caused by undigested food. Decreases pathogens/bacteria in waterers & can be used to disinfect cages/ trays.

ACV can be added to feed, or diluted in a drench or put in container for ad –lib drinking in a container /trough. For Drinking /Drenching: ACV must be diluted with water min. 50/50. Daily Dosage Rates as follows (per head /day):



Frequency: Daily

In: Feed/Water/Drench

Who:

All animals but especially those with health issues / problems

- Cows: 60ml/head/day; Calves: 20ml/head/day
- Mastitis: 120ml 2x /day for 3 days then 60ml 2x/day for further 7 days
- Milk Fever: 120ml/day for 6 wks prior & 3wks post calving
- Fertility: From 35 DIM—Cows 120ml, Heifers 60ml/day
- Post Drying Off: 120ml/ day for 7 days



Frequency: Daily

In: With feed

Who:

All animals but especially those with health issues / problems

- Piglets: From 6wks old, 15ml/hd Daily
- Pigs: 30ml/hd/ day



Frequency: Daily

In: With water only

Who:

• Chickens: 20ml/litre of water

• Chicks: 5ml/litre of water.

Do not leave ACV in waterers the whole time. Add it for no longer than one week in every month. Do not add it to feed. Wet food is prone to develop bacteria, not prevent it.



Frequency: Daily

In: With water only

Who:

Sheep, Goats & Alpacas

• Young: 10ml/day 0ml/litre of water

• Adults: 20ml/litre of water



Frequency: Daily

In: With Feed

Who:

60ml twice /day in each feed

• For Fly Repellent: Dilute 50/50 with Water

• Hoof Soak: Dilute 50/50 with Water



Frequency: Daily

In: With Feed

Who:

All and especially those with health issues

Cats: 5ml/day

• Small Dogs/ Puppies: 15ml/day

Medium Dogs: 15ml/day

Large Dogs: 20 ml/day



Frequency: Daily

In: With water only

Who:

• Young Birds: 5ml per litre of Water

• Adult Birds: 10ml per litre of Water
